Mission Statement

The aims and practice of Boutcher School seek to reflect the life and teachings of Jesus Christ as told in the Gospels. The School Agreement

The three golden rules:

Everyone in our school has a right to learn.
Everyone in our school has a right to feel safe.
Everyone in our school has a right to respect.

The school will:

- **Provide a safe and happy environment for all children.**
- **Encourage children to do their best at all times.**
- **Provide an appropriate curriculum to meet the needs of all children.**
- **Achieve high standards of work and behaviour by providing opportunities for children to develop positive social relationships, self-esteem and a sense of responsibility.**
- **Ensure that all pupils are made aware that unacceptable behaviour will not be tolerated and may result in fixed term exclusion.**

- **Be open and welcoming and offer opportunities for parents to be involved in the life of the school.**
- **Report formally and informally on your child's progress each term.**
- **Provide homework to support the curriculum.**

Parent / Carer Agreement

The Parents will:

- **Ensure that their child attends throughout each school term and arrives at 8:50am.**
- **Ensure that their child wears the correct school uniform, labelled clearly with their name.**
- **Inform the school if their child is absent by telephone on first day of absence by 9:30am.**
- **Make the school aware of any concerns that might affect the child's work or behaviour as soon as they become apparent.**
- **Support the child's homework.**
- **Attend parents' meetings about their child's progress and school information meetings.**
- **Support the school's guidelines for behaviour.**
- **Respect all members of the school community, abiding by their policy of zero tolerance towards rude and aggressive behaviour.**
- **We will support the school approach to online safety and not deliberately upload or add any images, video, sounds or text that could upset or offend any member of the school community.**
- **Raise concerns or ask for clarification about a school procedure directly with the relevant staff.**
- **Inform the school of any concerns your child may have with their relationship with other children so that we can resolve any issues with the children.**
- **Read all information sent home as this gives me important details of relevant policies, meetings, workshops, activities, newsletters and open days.**

Pupil Agreement

The pupils will:

- **Be kind and speak politely to everyone at school.**
- **Come to school regularly and on time.**
- **Look after the school surroundings.**
- **Follow class agreements and school rules.**
- **Accept responsibility for the things I do.**
- **Be responsible for my school work and homework, making sure that it is completed well and on time.**
- **Ask for help if I need it and try my best in all that I do.**
