

**Pupil Premium 2020- 21 77,320**

Pupil premium funding is used to narrow the gap in attainment for disadvantaged pupils.

Barriers to achievement faced by eligible pupils:

- Poor language skills
- Low level literacy in the home environment
- Lack of conducive home learning environment
- Lack of wider learning opportunities
